Are you entitled to free meals?

If you are in receipt of certain benefits or have a household income that does not exceed the current government threshold, you could be entitled to free meals for your child. Did you know the uptake of free school meals has a direct link to the funding schools receive?

FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

We want to ensure that every child receives the help they need. The Welsh Government offers support with Free School Meals and School Essentials such as uniform, kit and stationery. Make sure you've checked your child's eligibility for Free School Meals. Even if they receive Universal Primary free school meals, more help could be available. If eligible, you can get up to £200 per child for School Essentials, plus extra funding for our school.
