FINANCIAL SUPPORT FOR FAMILIES

We want to ensure that every child receives the help they need. The Welsh Government offers support with Free School Meals and School Essentials such as uniform, footwear, sports kit, stationery and equipment for after school activities liking learning a musical instrument or classroom essentials including pens, pencils and bags as well as laptops and computers. Make sure you've checked your child's eligibility for Free School Meals. Even if they receive Universal Primary free school meals, more help could be available. If eligible, you can get up to £125 per child in primary and £200 for year 7 pupils. You can apply online for a grant by visiting www.denbighshire.gov.uk/school-essentials-grant
